



Golf Course Rules

Rules Applicable to Guests at Hillwood Country Club:

1. Four (4) hours is the maximum time required to complete 18 holes of play.
2. ALTERNATIVE SPIKES AND GOLF ATTIRE
 - A. The club has adopted a spikeless policy. If you are not sure if your spikes conform, please check with one of the golf professionals in the golf shop.
 - B. Proper attire is required on the **golf course, practice areas, and the putting green**. Improper dress is defined as blue jeans, tennis shorts, unhemmed shorts or skirts, cargo shorts/pants, running shorts/pants or sweatpants, swimwear, shirts with slogans, shirts without collars for men (other than turtlenecks), shirttails not tucked in for men, halter tops, tube tops, boots or street shoes (tennis or running shoes are allowed), and baseball/golf caps worn backwards. Pants or shorts with belt loops must be worn with a belt.
3. GUEST RULES
 - A. LOCAL GUESTS:
 1. Local guests are defined as guests who are residents of Davidson, Cheatham, Dickson, Robertson, Rutherford, Sumner, Wilson and Williamson counties.
 2. In season (April 1 through September 30), local guests may not play on weekends and holidays.
 3. For purposes of the "Local Guests" rule, a student attending school in Davidson County, but who lives outside Davidson County, is considered to be a local guest.
4. ELECTRIC GOLF CARTS/ WALKING CARTS
 - A. Golf carts must:
 1. Stay at least 30 yards from tees and greens.
 2. Stay on the cart paths on all par 3's and elsewhere as directed by the Greens Superintendent.

3. After the Bermuda fairways become dormant, golf carts are required to stay on the cart paths at all times.
- B. Only players 16 years of age or older with a valid driver's license may use a golf cart.

5. PRACTICE RANGES

- A. The length of the practice area makes it necessary that anyone practicing be aware of those players on the 17th and 18th fairways. **DO NOT** hit a club that might cause a ball to injure them. It is your responsibility and liability if you injure someone!

NOTICE: Anyone observed intentionally hitting balls out of the driving range will be subject to a fine or suspension.

- B. Guests are permitted to use the practice areas only when accompanied by a member, and are limited to using the practice area 1 time per month.

6. LIGHTNING POLICY

In the event of threatening weather, three short blasts of the siren will halt play or practice. You **MUST** stop playing or practicing immediately. One long blast will resume play.
