TENNIS RULES

HILLWOOD AND WHITWORTH

1. The facilities will be open to members, and their spouses, children and guests daily unless special event/holidays have been scheduled. All players and their guests are required to register in the Pro Shop prior to play.
2. Court Reservations for outdoor courts:
 - a. All courts can be reserved up to a week in advance.
 - b. A reservation will be canceled if the member does not show up within 15 minutes of the scheduled time.
 - c. Reservations can be made for no more than a two-hour duration.
 - d. Indoor rental is \$16.00 per hour.
3. Indoor contract season (third Monday in October for 26 weeks)
 - a. All contract times that consisted of at least TWO members or member's spouse in the previous season can be renewed for the next season. If the time was a singles contract, only ONE member is required for renewal.
 - b. Beginning September 1st, all remaining Indoor Contracts will be given to players, groups consisting of the most members on a first come first serve basis.
 - c. To guarantee a contract time requires a \$100.00 non-refundable deposit by August 30, which will be applied to total fee.
 - d. Non-members participating in contract time will be charged \$200.00.
4. Guest Policy
 - a. There is a \$10.00 fee per ADULT guest and a \$5.00 fee per JUNIOR guest.
 - b. A non-member can only take lessons or clinics if accompanied by a member.
 - c. Participation in Hillwood sanctioned youth activities is limited to dependents, age 25 and under, of members.

5. Hours of Operation

Daily: 8:00 A.M. - 9:00 P.M.

HRAC @ WHITWORTH

Daily: 6:00 A.M. - 10:00 P.M.

- a Outdoor courts are open April 1 through November 1
 - b The indoor courts are available year-round
 - c At both facilities, if there are no reservations made after 7:00 p.m., the courts will close.
6. Members and their spouses will have priority on clay, grass and indoor courts at all times.
 7. Scheduled leagues, tournaments and clinics have priority on all courts. However, from Friday at 4:00 P.M. to Sunday at 9:00 P.M. there shall always be a minimum of two courts available for member play.
 8. Proper tennis attire is required to be worn at all times. Shirts with collars are preferred, however, T-shirts are permitted if in good taste as determined by the professional staff. Unacceptable attire includes, but is not limited to, jogging attire, gym shorts, walking shorts, sleeveless shirts on men and bathing suits.
 9. Tennis shoes with non-marking smooth soles are the only permissible shoes allowed.
 10. Tobacco products are not permitted on courts.
 11. Outings
 - a. All events using more than 4 courts must be approved by the Tennis Director.
 - b. All food and beverage for outings must be purchased from the club.
 12. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult unless engaged in tennis activities approved by the Tennis Director.
 13. The Tennis Director will use his discretion in directing all play, activities, and enforcement of club policies and rules.

These Tennis Rules may be altered and amended by the Board of Directors in accordance with Part II, Article 2 of the By-Laws of the Club.
